#### 4 BRIDGE STREE

his is a rarely-available, traditional, 4/5 bedroom, semidetached, stone-built house which stands in a picturesque conservation area in Haddington, only a few minutes' walk from the town centre.

Internally, the rooms are generously proportioned and offer versatile living space, which now requires upgrading. This property offers an exciting renovation opportunity and huge potential for the owner to redesign and create a very desirable family home.

On the ground floor, a hallway welcomes you into the property. To the left is a family room, bedroom, bathroom and utility room/kitchen and to the right is a reception room/5th bedroom, cloakroom and a study which leads to a conservatory. On the first floor there is a kitchen, bathroom, large sitting room and 3 double bedrooms. There is also a large attic which could provide further accommodation or provide useful storage space.

Externally, to the rear of the property, there is a large, mature walled garden with a detached double garage and driveway for off-street parking.
