LOCATION, LOCATION:

With a charming village feel, scenic green spaces, and striking Georgian architecture, Edinburgh's prestigious and historic Stockbridge is one of the most desirable areas of the city. A pleasant fifteen-minute stroll from the City Centre it is home to a wonderful selection of independent artisan shops, and boutiques, including Daisy Cheynes, and Galerie Mirages along with tempting cafés and eateries like Herbie's of Edinburgh Deli, La Bocca, and Artisan Roast.

Crowds flock to attend the popular Sunday market which sells global street food, crafts, and delicious fresh homemade produce. Raeburn Place houses a Sainsbury's Local and Co-op Food whilst there is a large Waitrose at Comely Bank and Marks and Spencer

at nearby Craigleith Retail Park. Outdoor walks include The Royal Botanic Gardens with its 70 acres of diverse natural beauty to the picnic spots, boating pond, and panoramic City views of Inverleith Park, which also houses the annual Foodies Festival. Also The Water of Leith walkway takes you from Stockbridge to the 19th Century Dean Village. The Scottish National Gallery of Modern Art is situated in close proximity. Other recreational pursuits include Glenogle Swim Centre, a tastefully restored Victorian swimming baths with gym.

Whilst accessible by foot, the area benefits from regular buses taking you swiftly to Edinburgh City Centre, Waverley Train Station, Edinburgh Bus Station, and the tram link to Edinburgh International Airport.
