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This beautifully presented, four-bedroom, terraced house has a fantastic location in a quiet cul de sac in the sought after Leith district in Edinburgh, a stones' throw from the Water of Leith walkway and cycle path, the Shore, and its array of independent shops, cafes and restaurants, Ocean Terminal Shopping Centre and Newhaven Harbour. This property has been very nicely decorated throughout in neutral colours, and offers generous accommodation for family living. On the ground floor there is a vestibule with access to the W.C., a hall with storage, a generous lounge, with a picture window, flooding the room with natural light and a glazed door leads out to the garden, a very attractive, modern kitchen, with sleek fitted units, appliances and plenty of space for dining, and a utility room, with fitted units. On the upper floor there is are two double bedrooms and two single bedrooms, one is currently used as a dressing room, a very smart family bathroom and the landing has storage and access to the floored attic. To the front of the property there is a driveway and to the rear there is a lovely, private, enclosed garden with Astro turf for easy maintenance, a patio area, decking for outside entertaining and a store.

From here, it is also a simple matter of a short walk into the city centre, with the option of using one of the many and frequent bus services that use this route. Leith is also perfectly located for ease of travel to many parts of the city and beyond. Ferry Road gives access to the west as well as routes out to the east. In both these directions, there are direct links with the City By-pass.
