Description

Quietly located on the first floor and accessed via a common stair or lift, the accommodation briefly comprises of a welcoming hallway with secure entry phone system and two storage cupboards, a bright and airy living/dining/ kitchen with French doors opening to a Juliette balcony with open views over the park and a range of sleek white wall and base units with co-ordinated worktops, a double bedroom with a full length window and built in wardrobes, and a modern four piece bathroom with separate shower cubicle.

Location

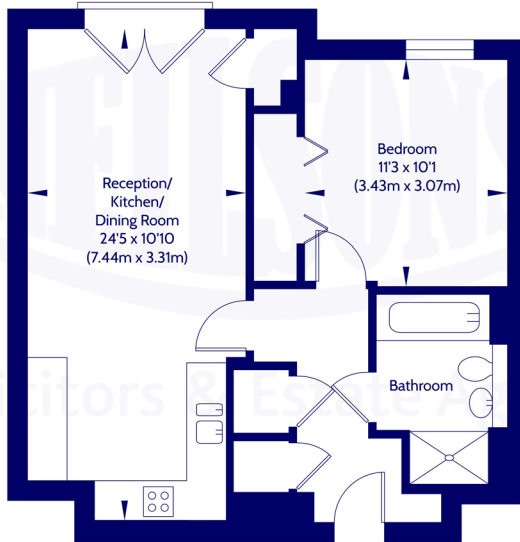
Lowrie Gait is situated in the historic town of South Queensferry, famous for its superb backdrop of the Forth Bridges and with excellent amenities including a great selection of local shops and supermarkets. There is convenient access to the Forth Bridges, A90 and M90 for commuting to any part of the country and Edinburgh Airport. The area also boasts Dalmeny Train Station, within close walking distance to the property, taking you to the heart of Edinburgh City Centre in approximately 20 minutes. The old conservation area of South Queensferry enjoys a picturesque setting and there are many delightful walks with views over the Estuary and tree lined winding roads for cycles or drives. Other local leisure facilities include a Sports Centre and Swimming Pool in the High School and a recreational Centre with tennis courts and a five-a-side football pitch. One can also visit the excellent pubs, cafes, restaurants and independent retailers. For those interested in sailing and other water sports, the Marina Yachting Club offers many opportunities. The Dundas Castle Estate includes a secluded loch, golf course and numerous routes for woodland and country walks. Further delightful nature trails and formal gardens can be found in Dalmeny and Hopetoun House.
