NEW TOWN

Situated in a conservation area in the New Town, the flat enjoys a prime location in one of Edinburgh's most prestigious postcodes. Its excellent situation offers residents the finest amenities the capital has to offer, all within easy walking distance. On your doorstep, you will find a superb choice of top-rated restaurants, cafés, fashionable bars and clusters of small speciality shops. The New Town hosts world-class shopping outlets including Harvey Nichols and Multrees Walk at St. Andrew Square, while Princes Street is lined with all the top-name High Street retailers. Nearby Broughton Street and Stockbridge offer a unique village atmosphere, and the independent outlets here are arguably some of the best in the country. A selection of some of Scotland's finest art galleries is all in close proximity, including the National Portrait Gallery, the Gallery of Modern Art, and the Scottish National Galleries. For days out, picnics or scenic walks, the tranquil Water of Leith at Stockbridge and the colourful Royal Botanic Gardens are only a short walk away. Edinburgh boasts some of the best private schools in the country, including Fettes and Edinburgh Academy, near the property. Commuting to any part of the city or other parts of the country, this area offers an abundance of public transport services. The tram line runs from nearby York Place all the way to the airport. There are over 35 bus routes departing from the area, and Waverley Station is within walking distance.
