



### TAKE A LOOK INSIDE

12 Lynedoch Place Lane is a very large, double garage situated on a charming cobbled lane in the heart of Edinburgh's West End.

The property has two secure up-and-over doors to the front and there is electric lighting and a car maintence/inspection pit.

The garage measures  $7.62 \times 5.87 \text{m}$  (41.99 sqm) and would allow for 2 cars to be parked with storage/workshop space at the rear.

#### THE LOCAL AREA


Coulters are also selling the ground and garden flat at 12 Lynedoch Place. The garage will not be sold separately unless the purchaser of the flat does not wish to buy it.
